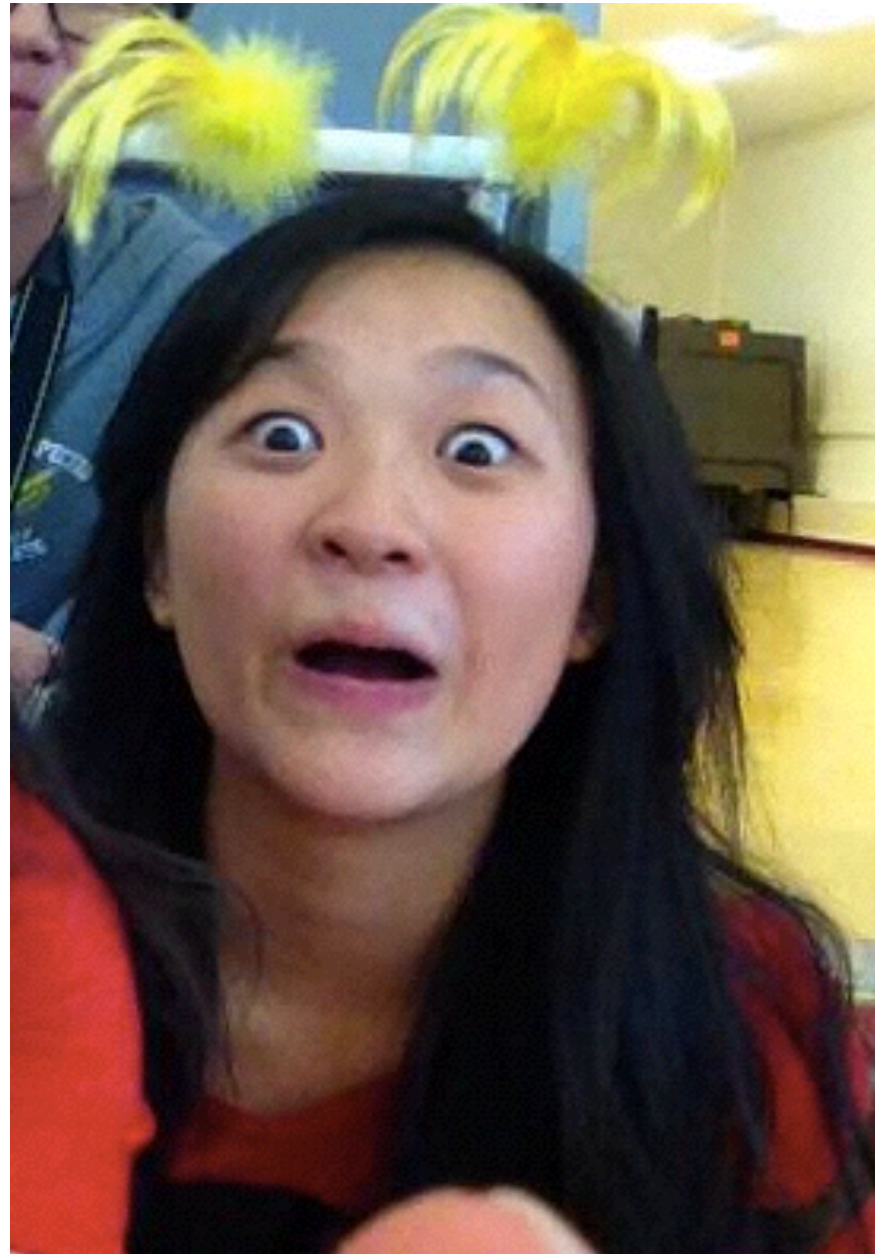
*I joined Key club my freshmen year because the club was really **welcoming** and became like a **second family** and I got to meet **upperclassmen**. I also really valued community service more!*
